



**Willow Grove Branch – 318 Davisville Road, Willow Grove
Adjacent to the Willow Grove Redevelopment District**

- \$8 million construction project of a 25,000 square foot, three-story facility with parking for 110 cars.
- Twenty-nine studios for individual voice and instrumental teaching, and group classes in Music Workshop, Fundamentals of Music, Dance, Percussion, Chamber Music and Creative Arts Therapy, and music resource library.
- 320-seat Leonard Mellman Recital Hall.
- Replaces and doubles the capacity of the existing Jenkintown Branch in Abington Township.
- Zoning approval granted by Upper Moreland Township in July 2006.
- Land Development approval granted July 2007.
- Ground Breaking anticipated October 2009
- Occupancy anticipated September 2010.

Economic Impact

- Current Jenkintown enrollment of 800 students anticipated to grow to 1500 by 2012, bringing over 1,000 families to Willow Grove each week.
- Current Jenkintown faculty of 50 anticipated to grow to 75, creating 25 permanent new full and part-time jobs.
- 320-seat Leonard Mellman Recital Hall will be available for use by other not-for-profit arts and civic organizations.
- Collaborative and enrichment projects with Willow Grove area schools, pre-schools and community organizations anticipated.
